<p style="text-align: center;">Areas of Learning</p> <p>As Geographers we will be learning about Bangladesh and how it compares to the UK. We will compare and contrast this environment to where we live now. We will consider the main similarities and differences in the Physical and Human Geography between the UK and Bangladesh.</p> <p>As scientists we will be continuing to learn about 'Uses of everyday materials.' We will be exploring materials, describing their properties and learning to classify them.</p> <p>As mathematicians we will be learning to about multiplication and division. We will need to be able to multiply and divide by 2, 3, 5 and 10. We will also begin to read scales to make measurements.</p> <p>As readers we will be focusing on our fluency by relying less on phonics and decoding and more sight reading. We will be writing stories using our own creative ideas.</p> <p>As caring citizens we will be learning about Fairtrade and their products. We will consider why supporting Fairtrade is important and how it makes a difference to other people's lives.</p> <p>As information technologists we will be learning about questioning and house computers and databases use questioning to define and provide information.</p> <p>As artists we will be exploring colours and using different mediums to find how to make desired colours and tones.</p> <p>Religious Education we will be thinking about how symbols help us to understand the Easter story. We will think about why is Easter the most important festival in the Christian calendar.</p>
	<p>Christian Values</p> <p>The value that we will be focussing on this half term is forgiveness. We will be thinking about why forgiving other is really important and how we can live out this value in school. We will also be listening to stories from the bible and learning how Jesus taught us about forgiveness and its importance.</p>
