Learning Showcase on The British Empire

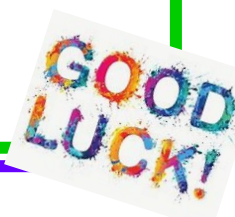
Year 4 knocked our socks off this morning with a brilliant Learning Showcase on The British Empire.
