We will use aerial photographs and google earth to compare and contrast the physical and human features of Ancient Greece to modern Greece as well as to the UK.

As writers.

We will be creating leaflets to compare and contrast different Greek Civilisations to our own society today. We will also reflect on our lasting legacy and create double page spreads about this.

In Religious Education we will be exploring Pentecost and the conversion of Saul to Paul. We will develop empathy towards Ananias and explain how he must have felt after his vision.

As Historians...

We will explore how sources of information can help us to learn about the Ancient Greek times - we will use knowledge bursts to find out more about the Greek times and also explore timelines to see where within History the Greek period can be found.

As a reader...

We will be continuing with our class novel 'Who let the God's out?' as well as exploring our English text 'Ride the wind' to immerse ourselves in a range of new vocabulary.
