**It's been an amazing week in school.**

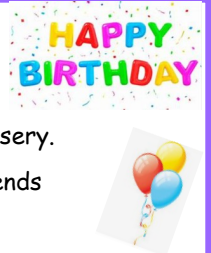


### BIRTHDAYS
