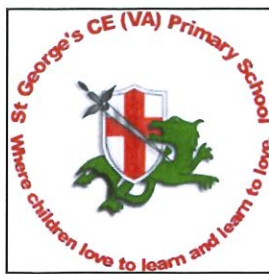

Minhah from Year 1, Adyan from Year 2 and Ayaan from Year 5.

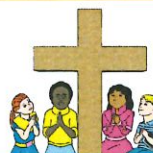
