Living out our values

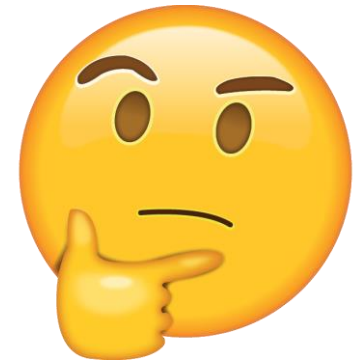
Never forgetting your manners

Amen

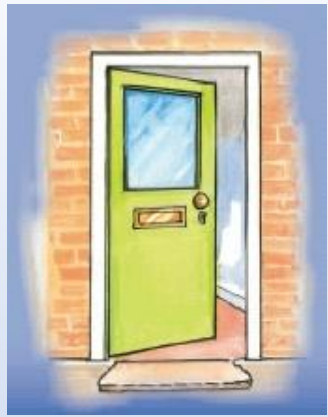


Response and Challenge
