We will also explore the events of Christmas and celebrate this special time within school.</p> <p>As Geographers... We will be exploring the location of North America and where this is in relation to the UK. We will learn about the geographical features of North America such as rivers, mountains and weather patterns. We will also explore the population across the continent and how this population is affected by their environment,</p> <p>As Artists... We will explore the artist Linda Gass and how her artwork was inspired by environmental issues.</p>
