




Year 2 Autumn Term Booklet 2022

<p style="text-align: center;">Successful Learners Areas of Learning</p> <p>As historians we will learn about the history of our local area. We will observe and handle evidence from the past and ask questions. We will consider what it was like to live in Hyde in the past. What used to happen here and how long ago. We will use pictures, stories and artefacts to find out about the past.</p> <p>As scientists we will be learning about animals and their habitats. We will also consider how the environment is going to change in response to the Autumn weather.</p> <p>As mathematicians we will be developing our knowledge of place value. We will be mastering our understanding of numbers to 100 and beginning to consider adding and subtracting. We will apply our knowledge of place value to solve problems and develop our reasoning skills.</p> <p>As readers we will continue learning phonics and learn to blend sounds to read. We will be focusing on handwriting- developing correct letter formations and learning how to join letters correctly.</p> <p>As artists we will be learning to use observation to improve our sketching.</p> <p>As design technologists we will be labelling sketches and designs. We will generate and communicate our ideas through a range of different methods.</p> <p>As information technologists we will be learning how to use a computer. We will be learning about e-safety- how to stay safe when using the internet. We will begin computer coding and start writing basic computer algorithms.</p> <p>As musicians we will be singing and chanting poems from the past.</p> <p>In Religious Education we will be learning about The Holy Bible and considering why it is so special to Christians. We will think about books that are special to us and which books are special to other religions.</p>
<p>Christian Values Thankfulness, Honesty, Love, Hope, Forgiveness, Compassion, Friendship, Justice.</p> <p>We will be exploring the value Hope. We will learn what hope is and why it is really important to have hope. We will think about the things that we hope for and how we can help make these things happen.</p>		
<p>Spirituality</p> <p>We will be thinking about our own feelings? Wondering how things have changed and how the children feel about the changes? We will be trying to put ourselves in our grandparents shoes by wondering what it would have been like when they were little?</p>		
<p>Building Learning Powers-Resilience</p>		
<p>We will be focusing on developing our resilience this half term. We will learn how to persevere when challenged and to understand that mistakes are great because this means that we are learning. Managing our distractions is going to become more important in year 2 and we will be look at strategies to use to concentrate for longer and focusing on our learning.</p>
