The children performed as Ancient Britons in costumes, held real ancient artefacts, made arrowheads and created their own cave drawings!

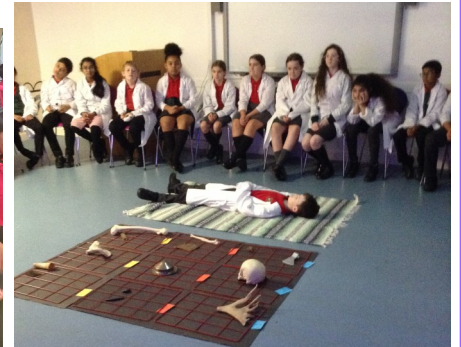
It was a great way to get excited about their learning challenge.
